PRIVACY NOTICE REGARDING THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA SUBMITTED BY FILLING IN THE CONTACT FORM

The Controller processes personal data in accordance with the laws and regulations governing the protection of personal data, i.e., in particular, Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data, as well as domestic law and our internal policies.

We are fully aware of the importance of protecting your personal data and your privacy.

We process the following categories of personal data:

- **Identification and address data:** first name, last name
- **Electronic contact data:** mobile phone number, e-mail address

We strictly process only such personal data as you communicated to us through the contact form.

The purpose of personal data processing is to approach you (possibly repeatedly) with commercial messages related to the services provided by the Controller.

The legal basis (grounds) for the processing of your personal data is your consent, which you may at any time revoke following this link – www.galenclinic.cz/odhlaseni.

We will always only process your personal data to the extent that this is strictly necessary for the given purpose, and only for 24 months from the day on which it was made available to us (but in any case not beyond the moment in which you revoked consent with the processing).

We process your personal data in the capacity of the data controller, i.e., we determine the purposes for which we collect and process your personal data and decide on the means for such processing.

The processing of your personal data may take place both in manual and in automated form. Automated data processing will take place within our own information systems. We have implemented measures to ensure that the only persons with access to your personal data will be the employees and processors who are involved in the processing, and to ensure that these employees and processors will maintain secrecy with respect to any and all facts, information, and (personal or other) data of which they learn during the discharge of their work duties.

We would like you to know that none of our decision-making is solely based on automated processing, including profiling. Your personal data will not be transferred to third countries.

We will always process your personal data in a fully transparent manner. At any time during processing, you may exercise your rights to access, rectification, and completion; erasure; restriction of processing; portability; or bring a complaint or raise an objection. If you exercise any such right, we will promptly notify you in writing of how your request was handled.
